  - o From 11am to 6pm on Sunday.
    - We will have other Poppy related articles for sale at the Sherway location.

You will also be able to purchase Poppies and related items or make donations every day from 9am to 5pm at the Branch. The Poppy Tables will be set up on the patio when weather is clear or under the carport should it be raining.

Please note that our parking lot and building have been leased for a Movie shoot on Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup> November 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> so please park on the west side of the building or in GO Station on those dates. Access to the building will not be permitted

Due to Covid-19, there will only be a very brief (5 to 10 minutes) Remembrance Day Ceremony at the Branch and at the Long Branch Cenotaph. In keeping with the required gathering limit protocols of under 25 people, we ask that ONLY Veterans, Volunteers, Executive Committee, Staff and Invited Dignitaries attend this event. There will not be free food or refreshments available in the Branch afterwards whether we are open at this time or still in lockdown mode.
